SCHOOL-WIDE EXPECTATION: Respect in the hallway

NAME OF THE SKILL: Respect all things in the hallway

PURPOSE OF THE LESSON / WHY IT'S IMPORTANT

1. Respect what belongs to others in the hallway

TEACHING EXAMPLES:

1. I'm walking down the hall by myself, and I notice an open backpack with a delicious snack falling out. I realize I forgot my snack and am tempted to take that one. I remember to keep my hands to myself and respect other people's belongings.

KID ACTIVITIES / ROLE PLAYS:

1. Role-play teaching example and other things that could be taken from the hall.

FOLLOW-UP / REINFORCEMENT ACTIVITIES:

1. Pre-correct / review as needed
2. Review games
3. Verbally praise
4. Ask five different students how they will respect all things in the hallway.
