Cool Tools Behavioral Lesson Plan

Universal Expectation: Respect Everyone

Name of the Skill/Setting: Enter classroom quietly-blend/ Classroom

Purpose of the lesson/Why it's important:

- Respect teachers lesson
- Respect other students' learning
- Not draw negative attention to yourself
- This is a lifelong adult skill

Teaching Examples:

1. You arrive late to school in the morning. Check in the office, go to your locker and get all your materials. Quietly enter the classroom, give your pass to your teacher and get to your seat without talking to anyone or making noises.
2. You just completed a recovery successfully. You were sent out because you had caused a distraction in class. You want to prove you are ready for class again. Pull yourself together before opening the classroom door. Enter quickly and quietly getting to your seat without drawing attention to yourself.
3. You had a problem with a friend and are just getting back to class after it has already started. Quietly open the door and get to your seat without drawing attention to yourself.

Kid Activities/Role-Plays:

- Set up a deal with another classroom. See which of your students could enter their class without being noticed, sitting down and ready to learn.
- Discuss some of the problems that you and your students see when students currently enter the classroom.
- Brainstorm with students when in life they would need to do this. Share with them when you have done this.

Follow-Up Reinforcement Activities:

- Use natural learning experiences during day to draw positive attention to the students when they do this well. Draw attention later, not right away.
- Pride when students are successful doing this.
