PBIS “Cool Tool” Lesson Plan

School Wide Expectations:

Be Ready

Be Responsible

Be Respectful

Lesson Topic: Finish Work/Classroom

Purpose of the Lesson:

1. It helps you learn.
2. It feels good to finish work.
3. You get a better grade or good report.

Teaching Examples:

Ask, “What does it look like to be responsible and finish your work?”

1. You need to do your homework, but you want to play video games.
2. You have classroom time to finish work, but your friend wants to talk.
3. You finish your work and you get teacher praise for doing a good job.

Check for understanding: Ask, “What did you do that was responsible?”, “How do you think the students felt?”, “How do you think the teacher felt?”, and “What good things happened because you were responsible and finished your work?”

Student Activities/Role Play:

1. The teacher passes out work and you do not know how to answer question number three, you skip it and you answer the other questions. Later, you go back to finish question number three and you feel confident and happy to be finished.
2. Role-play using class time wisely to finish work.
3. Role-play being at home and wanting to play video games, but needing to finish homework. You decide to play the game until you reach the next level, save the game and finish your homework.

Follow up/Reinforcement Activities:

1. Verbal praise when a student finishes their work.
2. Reinforce with “Buzz Bucks”.
