PBIS “Cool Tool” Lesson Plan

School Wide Expectations:

Be Ready
Be Responsible
Be Respectful

Lesson Topic: Look & Watch /Classroom

Purpose of the Lesson:

1. It is important to know what your teachers and classmates are saying/doing.
2. So that you do not miss important information.
3. When you are looking at someone they know that you are listening.

Teaching Examples:

Ask, “What does being respectful by paying attention look like?”

1. The teacher is talking about the morning message (daily schedule). You need to look and watch so that you know what the schedule is today.
2. The teacher gives a direction. You are not listening. You need to look and watch so that you know what group you will play in.
3. You are working in a small group. Your friend is helping you with a problem. You need to look and watch your friend, so you understand.

Check for understanding: Ask, “What did you do that was respectful?”, “How do you think the students felt?”, “How do you think the teacher felt?”, and “What good things happened because you were paying attention?”

Student Activities/Role Play:

1. Practice when to look and watch with cues.
2. Teacher demonstrates what it looks like when you are not looking and watching.
3. Role-play looking and watching the teacher and other students in the classroom.

Follow up/Reinforcement Activities:

1. Verbal praise when a student is looking and watching.
2. Reinforce with “Buzz Bucks”.
