PBIS “Cool Tool” Lesson Plan

School Wide Expectations:

Be Ready
Be Responsible
Be Respectful

Lesson Topic: Being respectful in the classroom

Purpose of the Lesson:

1. To maintain respectful environment in the classroom.
2. To create a learning environment where students feel respected.

Teaching Examples:

1. Teacher asks a question. You raise your hand and wait to be called on to answer the question.
2. Students come into class. There are 2 directions on the board. Student follows directions immediately.
3. Student answers question in class but has incorrect answer. Other students listen respectfully, knowing that nobody's perfect, and do not make fun or tease the student.

Student Activities/Role Play:

1. Teacher asks a question in class. Student raises hand and is called on to answer. Student gets the answer wrong. Discuss why we need to raise hand and wait to be called on, and why it is hurtful if we are incorrect and get teased.
2. Have students practice coming into room and following directions.

Follow up/Reinforcement Activities:

1. Praise and give “Buzz Bucks” to students you feel are being respectful in the classroom.
2. Remind students of school expectations regularly.
