NAME OF THE SKILLS: <u>Use all equipment safely</u>. <u>Play fair</u>. <u>Listen to all adults</u>.

PURPOSE OF THE LESSON / WHY IT'S IMPORTANT

- 1. To teach proper use of equipment
- 2. To listen to all adults

TEACHING EXAMPLES:

- 1. You are at recess. Your friend is at the top of the slide. You want to run up the slide the wrong way but you remember you need to be safe and wait for your friend at the bottom.
- 2. You want to go on the monkey bars. There is a big line. You want to cut in front but remember it is important to take turns. So you go to the end of the line.
- 3. The whistle blows and you want to play longer. You remember the rules and line up quickly, quietly and now!

KID ACTIVITIES / ROLE PLAYS:

- 1. Role play teaching example # 1 (on playground)
- 2. Role play teaching example # 2 (on playground)
- 3. Role play teaching example # 3 (on playground)

FOLLOW-UP / REINFORCEMENT ACTIVITIES:

- 1. Pre correct / review before recess / lunch
- 2. Review games
- 3. Verbally praise and give "keys" to students who follow rules and play the new games
- 4. Teach 4 new games per trimester
