Lesson Topic: Slide Down the Slide/Playground

Purpose of the Lesson:

1. Walking up the slide, you can slip and fall.
2. You need to take turns.
3. So that no one gets hurt using the slide.

Teaching Examples:

Ask, “What does being safe on the slide look like?”

1. You are sliding down the slide and another kid is walking up the slide. You do not want to collide and get hurt. You ask the kid to please get off the slide before you go down.
2. You grab the bar, to swing and drop on the slide. You fell hard on the slide and hurt yourself. Next time you go down without swinging on the bar and you do not get hurt.
3. Five kids are waiting to go down the slide and you want to go and start to push the kid in front of you. You stop because you remember you don’t want anyone to be hurt and wait your turn.

Check for understanding: Ask, “What did you do that was safe?”, “How do you think the students felt?”, “How do you think the teacher felt?”, and “What good things happened because you were safe on the slide?”

Student Activities/Role Play:

1. Practice sliding down the slide appropriately.
2. Brainstorm reasons it is important to slide down the slide.
3. Role-play asking someone to be safe on the slide.

Follow up/Reinforcement Activities:

1. Verbal praise when a student is being safe on the slide.
2. Reinforce with “Buzz Bucks”.
